2013 was an exciting year for AIDS Arms. In October, the HIVE opened to provide prevention education and a place for individuals with HIV to meet and interact in a safe and relaxed environment.

AIDS Arms was awarded a second SPNS project, Viviendo Valiente, and was renewed for another seven years for the National Institutes of Health's AIDS Clinical Trials Research Group, being one of the few community based organizations in the country participating.

AIDS Arms enrolled patients and clients for the first time into the ACA (Affordable Care Act) Marketplace Plans, being certified as a Community Designated Organization.

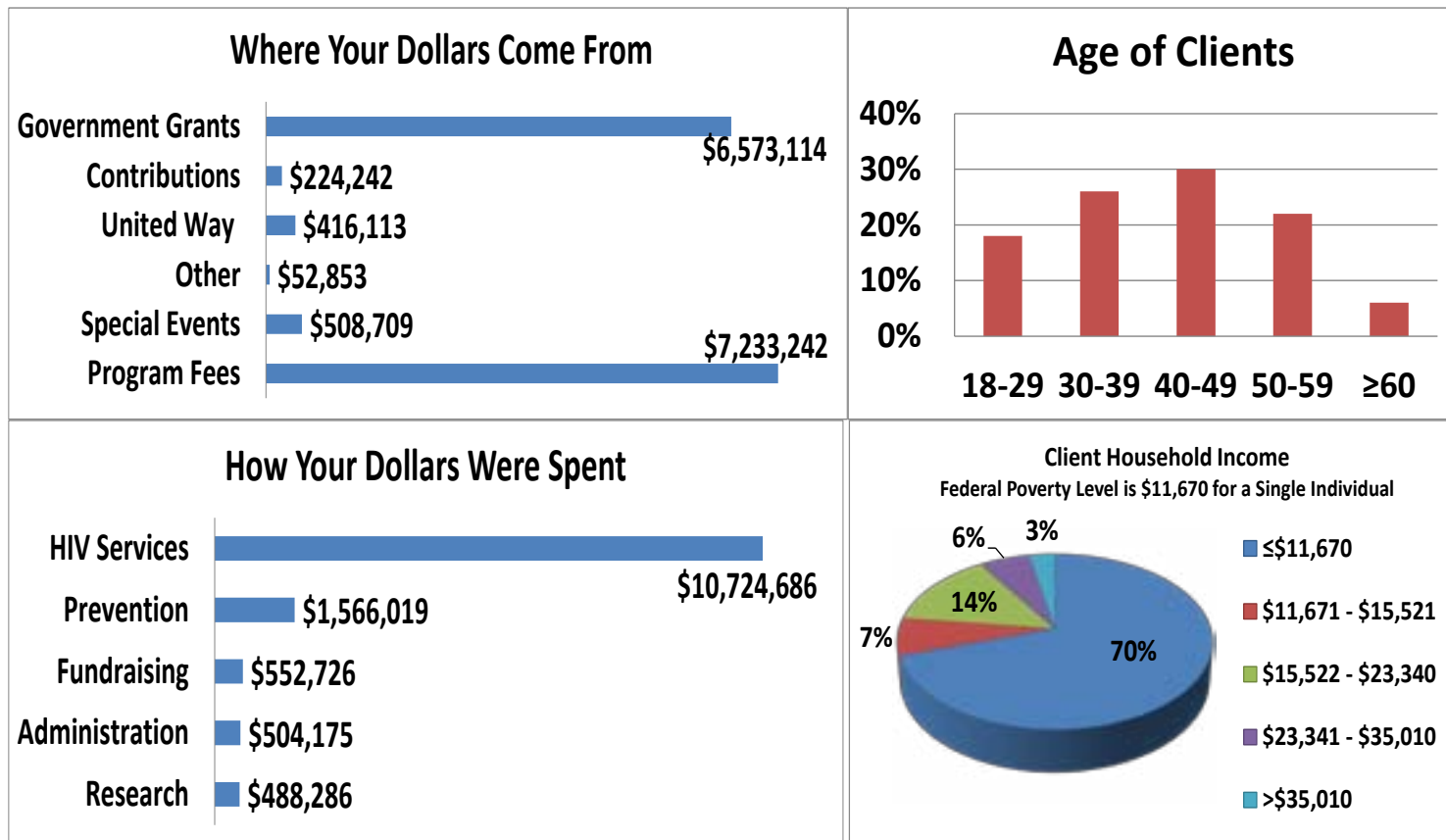
In 2013, the number of patients in care increased by 15%, with 1,627 patients seen during the year. Finally, a new social media program was begun, funded by DIFFA, and received state and national recognition for providing prevention messages in new and unique ways.

And for the first time in history of LifeWalk, we achieved the half-million dollar mark.

You change lives

“Joe”

“Joe” came to AIDS Arms fresh out of jail. He was on parole and was adamant about getting things together. He made it a priority to come to the Trinity Health and Wellness Center. He also began treatment for depression and his health began to improve.

In prison, he was beaten up by a gang and lost many of his teeth. He worked with Ryan White funded dental services, enabling him to chew his food and improve his overall oral care. Despite his difficulties, he has maintained viralogical suppression and improved CD4.

During Thanksgiving, his sister was hospitalized, and his family was going to be without a Thanksgiving meal. Thanks to AIDS Arms partner, Gents of Distinction, a Thanksgiving meal was donated to his family. He was overjoyed and brought his mother with him to his next appointment to thank us.

“Edwardo”

At the end of 2013, “Edwardo’s” apartment building burned down. He was HIV positive and living on fixed income. He came to AIDS Arms with only the clothes on his back. Because of your support of the AIDS Arms Community Resource Closet, he was provided bedding, kitchen items, and clothing. Thank you for providing basic necessities – gifts so critical to maintaining a healthy, stable life.

“Angie”

“Angie” was HIV positive, unemployed, taking care of her 5 year old daughter, and facing eviction. Desperate for help, she found the number for the Greg Dollgener Memorial AIDS Fund (GDMAF), one of AIDS Arms’ many community partners.

AIDS Arms and GDMAF took action immediately – they worked together on negotiating with Angie’s landlord, found her rental assistance until she could get back on her feet and gas money to get to and from medical care at AIDS Arms Peabody Health Center in South Dallas.

Angie is now employed, working very hard to make ends meet, and has a secure place for both her and her daughter to live. Unable to provide a holiday for her 5 year old daughter, AIDS Arms donors made it possible for her to give several wonderful gifts on Christmas day.

Funds from LifeWalk support the following programs at AIDS Arms:

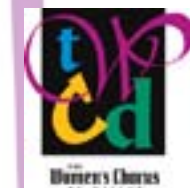
- Two medical facilities, the only HIV- specific clinics existing in South Dallas and Oak Cliff.
